OLD BUSINESS

1. **BILL NO. 21-06 ORDINANCE NO. 1055 AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 210.760 OF THE CITY OF BUCKNER, MISSOURI MUNICIPAL CODE.**

OLD BUSINESS

- 1. BILL NO 21-05 ORDINANCE NO. 1054 AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 610.080 AND 610.110 OF THE CITY OF BUCKNER, MISSOURI MUNICIPAL CODE.**

City Administrator Bobadilla stated that the city gets one or two request a year for a peddler license. The current ordinance makes the city do a background check and issue an ID for all requests. The amended ordinance will make the person applying for the peddler license provide a criminal background report and ID card to the city before a license will be issue. Alderman Norris made a motion to suspend the rules to allow for a second reading. Alderman Ross seconded the motion. All Aldermen voted aye.

- 2. DISCUSSION, CONSIDERATION, AND POSSIBLE ACTION regarding handling of citizen's complaints.**

Alderman Kolle stated that he would like to see an online form made available to allow citizens to report any code complaints or concerns. All the Aldermen agreed and instruct the City Administrator to create such form.

- 3. DISCUSSION, CONSIDERATION, AND POSSIBLE ACTION regarding repairs to a pump at Echo Ridge Lift Station.** City Administrator Bobadilla explained that the second pump needs repair. The cost to repair the existing pump is \$7,161.76 and will take two to three weeks or \$12,199.00 purchase a new pump with a twelve to fourteen weeks delivery time. Alderman Norris made a motion to repair the existing pump for \$7,161.76. Alderman Butts second the motion. All Alderman voted aye.

ELECTED OFFICIAL'S COMMENTS

Alderman Butts thanked the City Administrator for getting public works crews on weed eating the park.

Alderman Norris informed the City Administrator that the Slow Kids playing sign on James Street can be removed.
