CALL TO ORDER

OLD BUSINESS

1. **DISCUSSION, CONSIDERATION AND POSSIBLE ACTION regarding approval of a Memorandum of Understanding for animal control.**
Alderman Butts made a motion to approve upon approval by the city's attorney. Alderman Norris seconded the motion. Five Aldermen voted aye; Alderman Jones voted nay.
2. **DISCUSSION, CONSIDERATION AND POSSIBLE ACTION regarding City Officials to participate in Fireworks in the Park event.**
Alderman Butts stated that the Park Board would like City Officials to assist with the Fireworks in the Park event on June 25, 2022. Alderman Butts stated that aldermen could help with parking control and the mayor could give a speech.

NEW BUSINESS

1. BILL NO. 22-04 ORDINANCE NO. 1066 AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 370.190 "HEADGEAR REQUIRED-MOTORCYCLES OR MOTORTRICYCLES" OF THE CITY OF BUCKNER, MISSOURI MUNICIPAL CODE.

Mayor Box stated that the amendment would get the city aligned with the State Regulations. Alderman Norris made a motion to suspend the rules to allow for a second reading by title only. Alderman Butts seconded the motion. All Aldermen voted aye. Mayor Box read the ordinance by title only. Alderman Jones made a motion to approve. Alderman Butts seconded the motion. Roll call vote as follows: Alderman Butts, Alderman Jones, Alderman Ross, Alderman Walcott, Alderman Norris, and Alderman Kolle all voted aye.

2. DISCUSSION, CONSIDERATION AND POSSIBLE ACTION regarding bids for the replacement of the air conditioner at the wastewater treatment plant.

City Administrator Bobadilla stated that the air conditioner at the wastewater treatment plant went out and, since it was such an old unit, that it can't be repaired. Bobadilla also stated that he had three different companies come out to the treatment plant and gave three different bids as to what size of unit to put in. One company proposed bid was for a 14 SEER heat pump system, another company was for a 16 SEER heat pump system; the last company's bid included the option for both. Alderman Norris stated the difference between the 14 SEER and the 16 SEER was a savings on average of \$14 per month. Alderman Butts made a motion to approve Jake's Industrial Bid on a 14 SEER heat pump system in the amount of \$7,333.00. Alderman Kolle seconded the motion. All Aldermen voted aye.

ELECTED OFFICIAL'S COMMENTS


