CALL TO ORDER

The Board of Aldermen of the City of Buckner, Missouri, met in a Business Session on September 1, 2022, in the Council Chambers located in Buckner City Hall. Mayor Darrel Box called the meeting to order at 6:00 pm and led the Pledge of Allegiance.

MINUTES

Alderman Butts made the motion to approve the August 18, 2022, Study Session Minutes. Alderman Jones seconded; all Aldermen voted aye.

OLD BUSINESS

1. DISCUSSION, CONSIDERATION AND POSSIBLE ACTION regarding dates for the Fall City-wide Clean up.

Mayor Box stated the AAA Trash Services had an open date on October 8th. Alderman Ross made a motion to approve. Alderman Kolle seconded the motion. All Aldermen voted aye.

NEW BUSINESS

1. DISCUSSION, CONSIDERATION AND POSSIBLE ACTION regarding the approval of an Eagle Scout project.

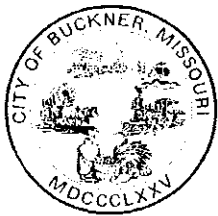

2. DISCUSSION, CONSIDERATION AND POSSIBLE ACTION regarding the approval of a contract from Mission Square to add a ROTH plan.

Mayor Box stated that this is another plan for city employees to save for retirement. Alderman Butts made a motion to approve. Alderman Walcott seconded the motion. All Aldermen voted aye.

3. DISCUSSION, CONSIDERATION AND POSSIBLE ACTION regarding establishing an on-call procedures for public works.

Mayor Box stated that this past weekend there was a situation where an apartment complex was without water. He couldn't get in touch with City Administrator Bobadilla

or Robert Hunter. He then went on the city's website and couldn't find an emergency number. Robert Hunter stated that all public works employees will be on a 2-week rotational on-call status and will carry his city issued phone. Alderman Kolle suggested getting a second phone. Alderman Butts made a motion to approve. Alderman Norris seconded the motion. All Aldermen voted aye.

4. BILL NO. 22-08 ORDINANCE NO. 1070 AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF BUCKNER, MISSOURI, FOR THE PURPOSE OF ESTABLISHING A PROCEDURE TO DISCLOSE POTENTIAL CONFLICTS OF INTEREST AND SUBSTANTIAL INTERESTS FOR CERTAIN OFFICIALS.

Mayor Box stated that this is an annual requirement from the State. Alderman Jones made a motion to suspend the rules and allow for a second reading by title only. Alderman Norris seconded the motion. All Aldermen voted aye. Alderman Jones made a motion to approve. Alderman Butts seconded the motion. Roll Call Vote as follows: Alderman Butts, Alderman Jones, Alderman Ross, Alderman Walcott, Alderman Norris, and Alderman Kolle voted aye.

5. DISCUSSION, CONSIDERATION AND POSSIBLE ACTION regarding alternative Christmas charitable events.

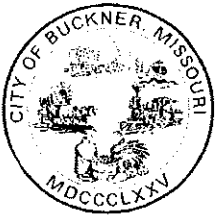

Alderman Jones asked about 108 Baker. City Administrator Bobadilla stated that the individual has a court appointment this Tuesday.

Mayor Box stated each Alderman has a copy of the 2022-2023 budget in front of them; this will go for their approval at the Sept. 15th meeting. Mayor Box also thanked Alderman Ross and Alderman Norris for their work during this process.
