CALL TO ORDER

The Board of Aldermen of the City of Buckner, Missouri, met in a Business Session on November 3, 2022, in the Council Chambers located in Buckner City Hall. Mayor Darrel Box called the meeting to order at 6:00 pm and led the Pledge of Allegiance.

MINUTES

Alderman Butts made the motion to approve the October 20, 2022, Study Session Minutes. Alderman Jones seconded; all Aldermen voted aye.

PUBLIC COMMENTS NONE

OLD BUSINESS

1. DISCUSSION, CONSIDERATION, AND POSSIBLE ACTION regarding Premier Pyrotechnics early pay option.

Mayor Box explained that the city has a three-year contract with Premier Pyrotechnics. Last year the city spent \$6,000. Premier Pyrotechnics is offering an incentive to pay early and receive an additional percentage of fireworks added to the show. Mayor Box asked Raquel Miles, Park Board President, if the Parks department would pay for this year's fireworks. Raquel Miles stated that in the past the city has always paid for the fireworks and that the rest of the park board will have to decide. Alderman Butts asked to table discussion until after the park board meets.

2. DISCUSSION, CONSIDERATION, AND POSSIBLE ACTION regarding the new generator at the wastewater treatment plant.

City Administrator Bobadilla stated that the new generator has been delivered to Central States warehouse. He obtained three bids for an electrician to disconnect the old generator and install the new generator. Citadel bid is \$7,600.00, North Kansas City Electric's bid is \$1,500.00, and Empire Electric's bid is \$960.00. In addition, Central States Generator gave a bid of \$2,500.00 for the old generator. Alderman Jones made a motion to approve Empire Electric's bid for \$960.00. Alderman Norris seconded the motion. All Aldermen voted aye. Alderman Norris made a motion to sell the old generator to Central States Generator for \$2,500.00. Alderman Butts seconded the motion. All Aldermen voted aye.

NEW BUSINESS

1. DISCUSSION, CONSIDERATION, AND POSSIBLE ACTION regarding Tyler Technology proposals.

City Administrator Bobadilla stated that Tyler Technologies has presented two new services. The first service is an Interactive Voice Response (IVR). This service will allow citizens the ability to pay their water bill over the phone 24 hours a day seven days a week. The cost is \$1.25 per transaction which will be passed on to the customers. The second service is a Notification for Utilities. This service could replace the city's current notification Textcaster with the addition of sending out text messages letting citizens know when their water bill is due. The cost of this services will be 10 cents per text. Alderman Butts stated that the IVR service could be helpful but doesn't see the notification services being needed. Alderman Butts made a motion to approve the Interactive Voice Response. Alderman Norris seconded the motion. All Aldermen voted aye.

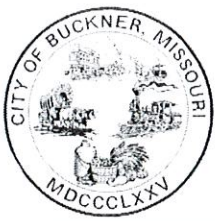
2. DISCUSSION, CONSIDERATION AND POSSIBLE ACTION regarding Diamond Computers proposals.

Jared Vaughn, supervisor for Diamond Computer, stated that the firewall for the servers is old and expired. The new firewall protection will cost \$3,429.40. Also, the camera system at city hall needs to be updated to allow video to be stored for a longer period. Currently, the camera system can store up to 3 days of video. The proposed system will store up to a year of video and the milestone video is allowed to be used in courts. The cost of the new system is \$18,962.82. Mayor Box stated that the current General Fund balance can't handle the cost of the new server for the cameras. Alderman Butts made a motion to approve the firewall for \$3,429.40. Alderman Ross seconded the motion. All Aldermen voted aye.

3. RECESS TO EXECUTIVE SESSION.

Alderman Jones made a motion to go into executive session. Alderman Butts seconded the motion. Roll call vote as follows: Alderman Norris, Alderman Walcott, Alderman Ross, Alderman Jones, and Alderman Butts voted aye. The Board of Aldermen went into executive session at 6:19 pm.

4. RECONVENE FROM EXECUTIVE SESSION. Alderman Jones made a motion to reconvene back into regular session. Alderman Butts seconded the motion. The Board of Aldermen reconvened back into regular session 7:28 pm.
