NEW BUSINESS

1. DISCUSSION, CONSIDERATION AND POSSIBLE ACTION regarding the Right of Entry Agreement with Jackson County.

Mayor Box stated that this agreement is a request by Jackson County due to their plans to replace the bridge by the park. Alderman Jones made the motion to approve. Alderman Butts seconded the motion. All Aldermen voted aye.

2. BILL NO. 22-12 ORDINANCE NO. 1074 AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 700.9 OF THE CITY OF BUCKNER, MISSOURI EMPLOYEE MANUAL.

Mayor Box stated that the amendment will require employees to give two weeks' notice, and department heads 30 days' notice, or forfeit their PTO payout. Alderman Norris made a motion to suspend the rules and allow for a second reading by title only. Alderman Butts seconded the motion. Attorney Mauer read the ordinance by title only. Alderman Norris made a motion to approve. Alderman Jones seconded the motion. Roll call vote as follows: Alderman Butts, Alderman Jones, Alderman Ross, Alderman Walcott, Alderman Norris, and Alderman Kalle all voted aye.

3. Recess to Executive Session

Alderman Jones made a motion to recess into Executive Session. Alderman Ross seconded the motion. All Alderman voted aye. The Board of Aldermen went into Executive Session at 6:26 pm.
