**CALL TO ORDER**

The Board of Aldermen of the City of Buckner, Missouri, met in a Business Session on January 5, 2023, in the Council Chambers located in Buckner City Hall. Mayor Darrel Box called the meeting to order at 6:00 pm and led the Pledge of Allegiance.

**MINUTES**

Alderman Butts made the motion to approve the December 1, 2022, Business Session Minutes. Alderman Norris seconded; all Aldermen voted aye.

**OLD BUSINESS**

**1. BILL NO. 23-02 ORDINANCE NO. 1078 AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING CHAPTER 395 "ATV AND UTV" OF THE CITY OF BUCKNER MUNICIPAL CODE.**

Mayor Box asked about page two, Line Item #E, subsection 3 "No person shall operate an ATV or UTV without a securely fastened seat belt" saying that he can see that for an UTV but wasn't sure for about a ATV. Alderman Ross stated that he would like to clean up Section 309.050 (E). Registration currently states that all must be renewed annually but section F (1) stated that registration and license is valid for two years, which he agrees with. City Attorney Mauer stated that the Board of Aldermen can go ahead and pass this ordinance as amended and he will make the changes. Alderman Norris made a motion to suspend the rules and allow for a second reading by title only as amended. Alderman Butts seconded the motion. All Aldermen voted aye. Attorney Steve Mauer read out loud the ordinance by title only. Alderman Jones made a motion to approve. Alderman Norris seconded the motion. Roll call as follows: Alderman Butts, Alderman Jones, Alderman Ross, Alderman Walcott, Alderman Norris, and Alderman Kolle all voted aye.

Alderman Jones made a motion to amend the agenda to discuss a change order for the Inflow and Infiltration project. Alderman Walcott seconded the motion. All Aldermen voted aye. Mayor Box stated that will be agenda item number one under new business.

**NEW BUSINESS**

**1. DISCUSSION, CONSIDERATION AND POSSIBLE ACTION regarding change order for the Inflow and Infiltration project.**

Mayor Box stated that the company that is in charge of the cleaning and televising of the sewer lines is asking \$3,300.00 to raise three manholes that are currently buried at the sod farm that is located in the North west corner of 24 highway. Alderman Jones made a motion to approve. Alderman Butts seconded the motion. All Aldermen voted aye.

**2. BILL NO. 23-01 ORDINANCE NO. 1077 AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOARD OF ALDERMEN OF THE CITY OF BUCKNER, MISSOURI AMENDING SECTION 210.1800 OF THE CITY OF BUCKNER MUNICIPAL CODE.**

City Attorney, Steve Mauer, stated that this ordinance matches state law for possession of marijuana due to the passing of Amendment 3. Alderman Butts made a motion to suspend the rules and allow for a second reading by title only. Alderman Kolle seconded the motion. All Aldermen voted aye. Attorney Steve Mauer read out loud the ordinance by title only. Alderman Butts made a motion to approve. Aldermen Norris seconded the motion. Roll call as follows: Alderman Butts, Alderman Jones, Alderman Ross, Alderman Walcott, Alderman Norris, and Alderman Kolle all voted aye.

**3. POLICE CHIEF REPORT**

Police Chief Hacker gave the following report for Police activity as of December 2022. (See attachment). Police Chief Hacker presented a Certificate of Appreciation to Officer Hickman, Officer Donato, and Officer McNair for working overtime. Officer Hickman was the only police officer present. Police Chief Hacker also introduced Anthony Uredi as a part time officer.

**ELECTED OFFICIAL COMMENTS**

Alderman Walcott thanked the police department for fixing existing police vehicles and public works for repairing the existing mowers and equipment.

Alderman Butts thanked public works for the snow removal during the past storm especially with the extreme cold temperature.

Mayor Box congratulated Officer Hickman for his Certificate of Appreciation, welcomed Tony Uredi to the police department, and thanked public works for their work treating streets during the last storm.
