CALL TO ORDER

The Board of Aldermen of the City of Buckner, Missouri, met in a Business Session on December 1, 2022, in the Council Chambers located in Buckner City Hall. Mayor Darrel Box called the meeting to order at 6:04 pm and led the Pledge of Allegiance.

MINUTES

OLD BUSINESS

1. DISCUSSION, CONSIDERATION, AND POSSIBLE ACTION regarding proposed changes to the ATV section of Buckner's Municipal Codes.

The Board of Aldermen directed the city's attorneys to make the following changes to the proposed amendment:

1. Clean up 2nd page item #6
2. 1st page 2nd paragraph change to 72 inches
3. 2nd page item #3, remove the reference for UTV
4. Add a section to make the registration fees the same as it is for golf carts

NEW BUSINESS

- 1. BILL NO. 22-14 ORDINANCE NO. 1076 AN ORDINANCE IMPOSING A SALES TAX AT A RATE OF THREE PERCENT ON ALL TANGIBLE PERSONAL PROPERTY RETAIL SALES OF ADULT USE MARIJUANA SOLD WITHIN THE CITY OF BUCKNER, MISSOURI, PURSUANT TO ARTICLE XIV, SECTION 2.6(5) OF THE MISSOURI CONSTITUTION SUBJECT TO THE APPROVAL BY THE VOTERS OF THE CITY AT THE GENERAL MUNICIPAL ELECTION TO BE HELD ON APRIL 4, 2023; DESIGNATING THE FORM OF BALLOT; AND DIRECTING THE CITY CLERK TO PROVIDE NOTICE OF SAID ELECTION.**

City Attorney, Steve Mauer, stated that since amendment 3 passed legalizing the use and sale of adult recreational marijuana the city can place a three percent sales tax. The proposed ordinance lets the city place it on the April's election otherwise the city won't be able to collect any sales tax. Alderman Butts made a motion to suspend the rules and allow for a second reading by title only. Alderman Jones seconded the motion. All Aldermen voted aye. Attorney Steve Mauer read out loud the ordinance by title only. Alderman Jones made a motion to approve. Alderman Butts seconded the motion. Roll call as follows: Alderman Butts, Alderman Jones, Alderman Walcott, Alderman Norris, and Alderman Kollé all voted aye.

- 2. DISCUSSION, CONSIDERATION AND POSSIBLE ACTION regarding Diamond Computers proposals.**

Mayor Box stated that the Microsoft software for the Police Department and City Hall servers are outdated and expired. Alderman Norris asked what funds will be paying for this purchase. Mayor Box replied that the Microsoft license for the PD server will all come out of the General Fund. The license fee for City Hall can be divided between the General Fund, Street Fund, and the Water/Sewer fund. Alderman Butts made a motion to approve. Alderman Kollé seconded the motion. All Aldermen voted aye.

- 3. DISCUSSION, CONSIDERATION AND POSSIBLE ACTION regarding bids for lawnmowers.**

Alderman Butts stated that currently public works has one mower that is running and two others that are old and can't get parts for the repairs needed. Alderman Butts stated that he likes the Bad Boy 60" but didn't know if there is funding available to make the purchase. Mayor Box stated that currently the General Fund has \$33,000 but have an upcoming payroll of \$21,000 next week and \$15,201 of outstanding checks. Leaving us around \$6,000 to \$7,000. Alderman Butts stated that this purchase is something that we should look at maybe when we get into the new year.

ELECTED OFFICIAL COMMENTS

Alderman Butts stated that holes on 24 highway have been patched by MoDot and asked if staff could contact MoDot about doing some permanent repairs to those intersections.

Mayor Box stated that the Mayor's Christmas tree lighting is this Saturday night, December 3rd, at 7:00.

Raquel Miles, Park Board President, said that at 6:00 pm the Christmas Parade will start with the choir singing at 6:30 pm.

Alderman Kolle asked if the police department has access to mental health services. Mayor Box replied that the City's insurance provider offers such a service. Alderman Kolle asked if staff could send out an email to all officers letting them know about this service.

Alderman Jones stated that Shop with a Cop will be December 10th; and the event start with a breakfast at 8:00 am.

City Administrator Bobadilla stated that a crew from Zenner has been working on the meters that were not reading since Monday. When they started there was 177 meters not working and that this morning the list was down to 78. The crew is here until Friday morning and will be leaving for the airport around 10:00 am. Public Works Superintendent Moffett stated that he spoke with one of the crewmembers before the meeting and the list is now down to 45. When the project began, we were at 71% working currently, we are now at 94% working.
